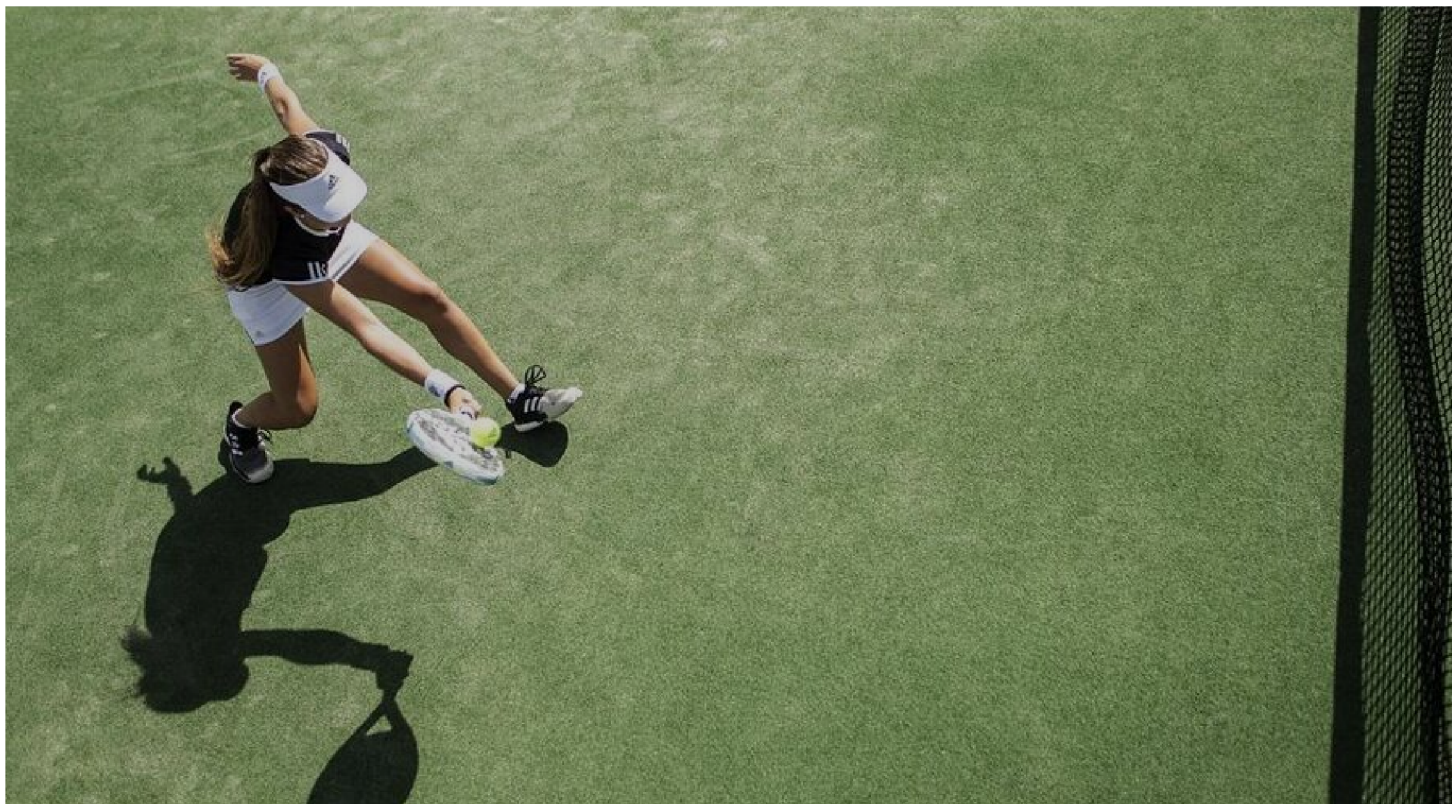


# Wimbledon traffic wardens win protection tennis championships
