

Dementia service saved after GMB campaign



Sandwell's only dementia care service has been saved today [18 November 2021] after a long-running GMB campaign.

Following consultations between management and trade unions and a public campaign, councillors in Sandwell rubber-stamped plans to keep the Walker Grange facility running.

The authority also committed to investing in the long term future.

Today's decision not only gives peace of mind to the residents and their families but also safeguards the jobs of more than 30 staff.
