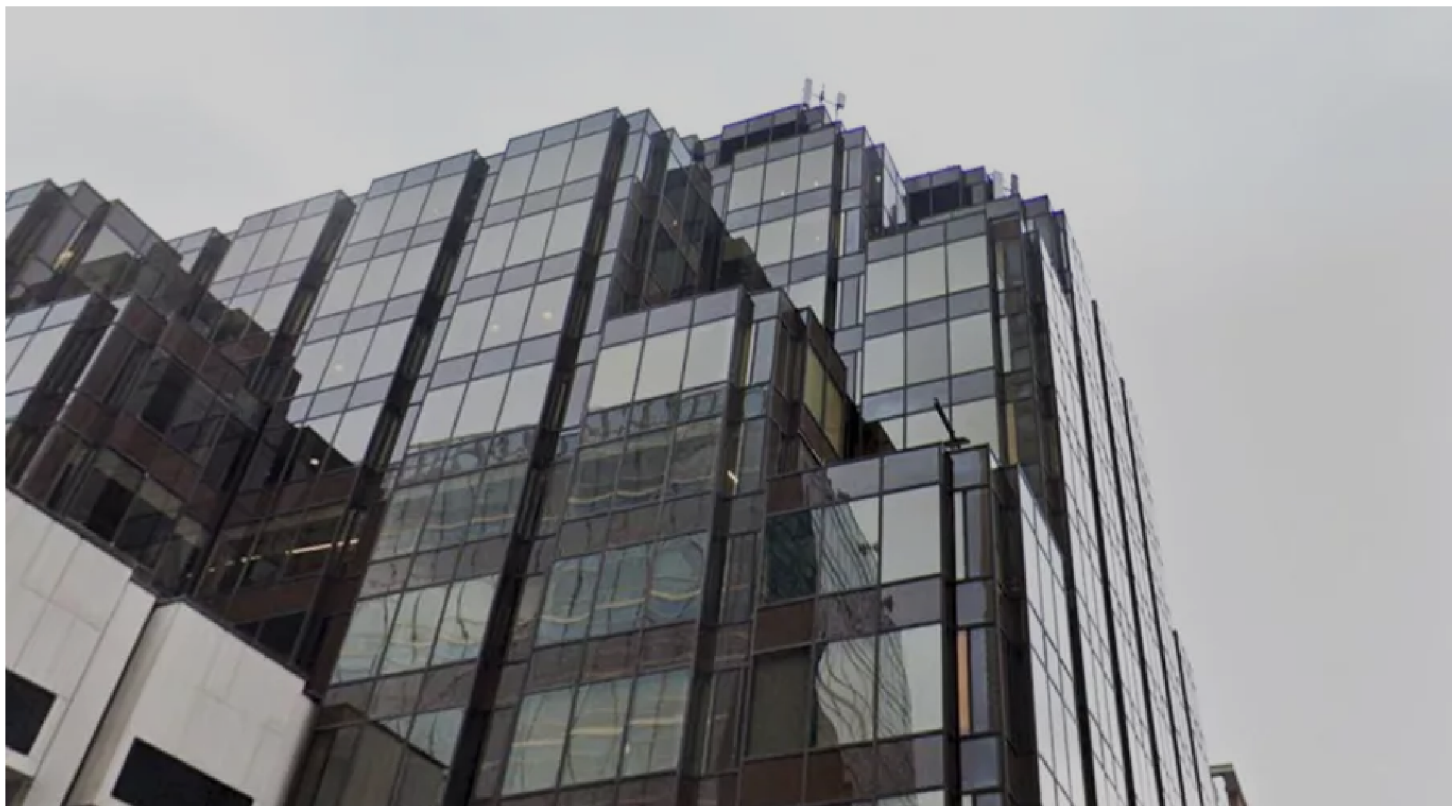


Labour's NPF delivers 'significant advances for working people'
