Strike ends at Wolverhampton incinerator



Inflation busting pay rise agreed to end dispute.

GMB members at the Energy from Waste site in Wolverhampton have called off any further strike action after coming to a pay agreement with the new management, North Midlands Operations Limited.

The new deal will mean salaries increase by 13.8% as well as one-off payments of up to £4,000.

This follows 3 days of strike action last month which saw the incinerator taken off line.
