

Thames Water High Court battle

'Futile'



GMB Union has described the High Court battle over Thames Water's finances as 'futile' - and says the company must be nationalised.

The debt-ridden water giant is subject to a hearing this week as negotiations continue as to whether the near-bankrupt firm should be placed into administration. [1]

Gary Carter. GMB National Officer, said:

"Creditors battling it out to loan Thames large sums of cash and increase its debt mountain of debt have the long-term interests of the company at heart. It's a futile exercise."
