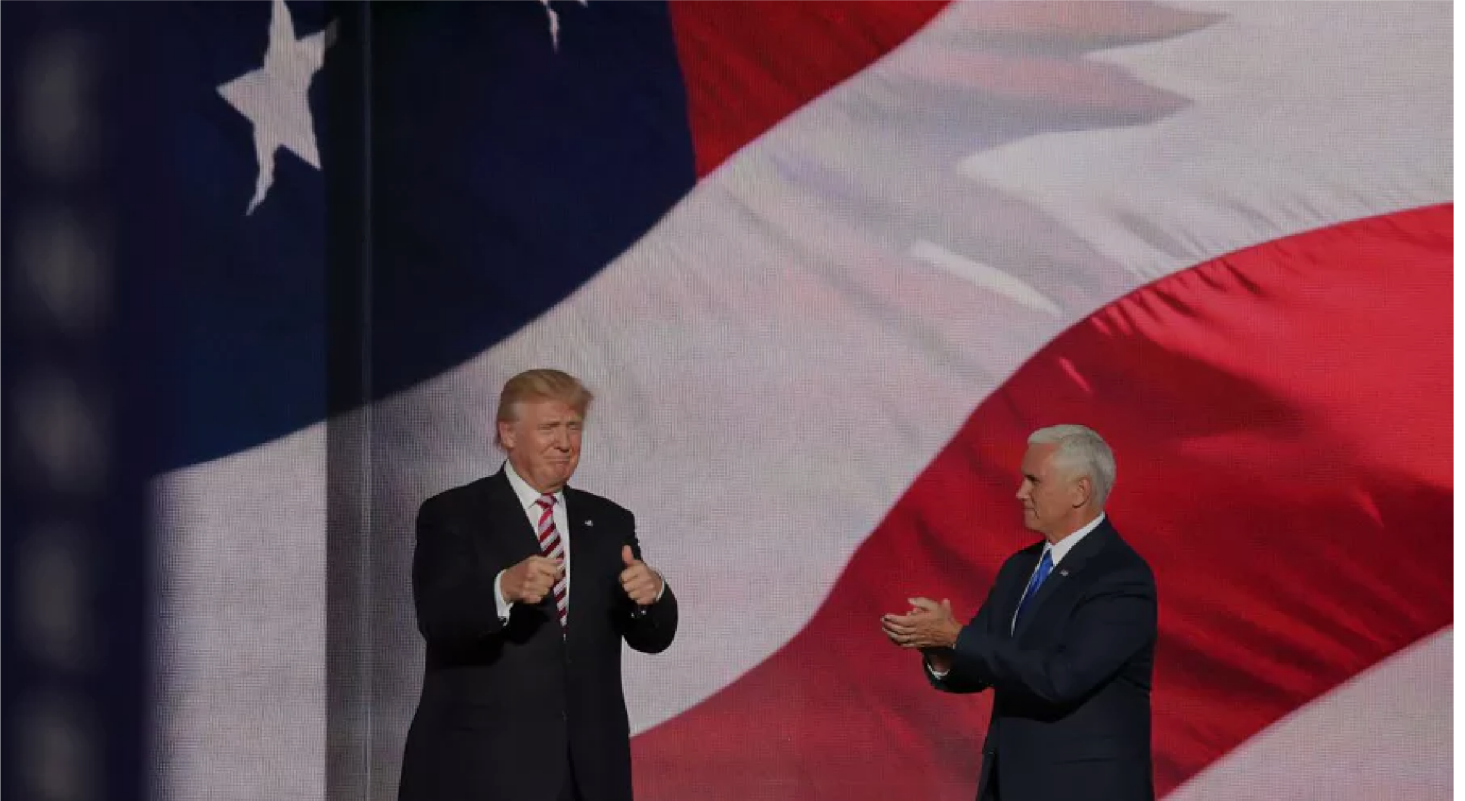


Trump insists NHS is absolutely on table in trade deal
