"The construction industry is struggling and today's announcement will be a much-needed boost to thousands of workers and the wider supply chain.

"At the same time, it is vital that the start of main construction work is handled safely and fairly, with clear avenues for workers to make their voices heard when concerns arise.

"That's why GMB is looking to engage with HS2's contractors to ensure that this railway is built as a world-class, unionised project."
