Will Dalton, GMB Organiser, said:

"During his tenure Nick Beighton has seen profits soar off the backs of hard-pressed workers.

"The company has grown substantially during the pandemic, with income sky-rocketing while its warehouse workers are forced into high pick rates and refused toilet breaks.
