JCB delivery drivers call off strike after 10 per cent deal



GMB members working at DHL for JCB should be rightly proud of themselves

JCB delivery drivers have called off a strike after GMB members accepted a pay rise of almost 10 per cent.

Dozens of GMB members, employed by delivery giant DHL, were due to walk out yesterday and today [23 and 24 May]

But bosses made a last minute offer of 9.5 per cent plus a £750 bonus.

GMB members voted on the offer yesterday and an 80 per cent majority accepted the deal.

"GMB members working for DHL for JCB should be rightly proud of themselves.

"They've been under attack for four years – faced changes to their contracts and a whopping pay cut.

"Now they're walking away with a big pay rise, a bonus and their heads held high.
