ASDA Pockets the Difference

In September 2024 GMB members working on the shop floor in ASDA head to the courts for the second stage in their historic battle for equal pay.

GMB, the union representing ASDA workers, are very likely to win the next round in the fight for pay justice on ASDA's shop floor.

Currently, ASDA's depot workers (who are mainly men) are paid between £1.04 and £3.74 more than ASDA's retail workers (who are mainly women)

GMB members on the shop floor say they are the ones who take the stock off the pallets and cages and depot workers are the ones who put the stock on the pallets and cages – so, what's the difference?

ASDA pocket the difference when they pay retail workers less than depot workers - this is about to stop.
